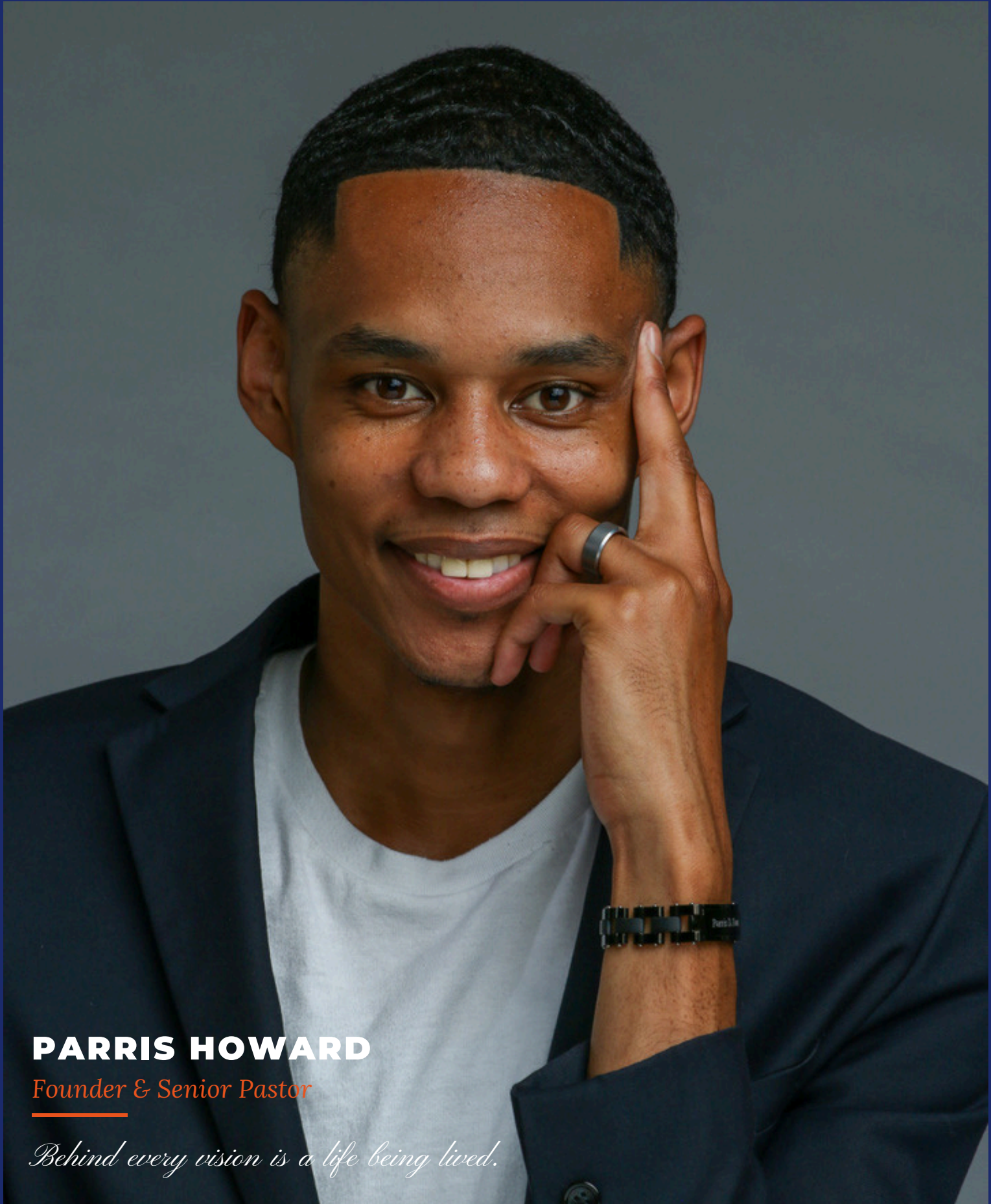

Behind every vision is a life being lived.

A WORD FROM OUR FOUNDER

Forged in obscurity and called out of darkness, God was preparing this place long before I ever drew my first breath. As a young boy I did not yet have language for what I was carrying, only a hunger I could not explain and an instinct to lean toward the wisdom of those who had lived longer than I had.

I did not yet know what God was forming in those quiet years or what He would one day call me to build. Out of much pain, much misunderstanding, and a long and turbulent road of becoming, God called me to pastor and to plant. Not for my own legacy. But for every person who desires to walk out their relationship with God the way Jesus modeled it – wholly – in spirit and in truth.

As a boy I would see visions of myself leading communion, conducting service flow, and standing before people to declare the Word of God. I would act those visions out in my bedroom, and it was there, in that small but sacred space, that God showed me the kind of leader He was fashioning me to be. I stand before you now as a man who has walked through the fire of being misunderstood, wrestled with his own religious pride, struggled to find his own identity, and learned to embrace the unfamiliar as the very place where God does His best work.

"What you hold in your hands is not simply a vision document – it is the fruit of everything that tried to stop it."

As I journeyed through various denominational contexts and educational seasons, I began to notice a consistent gap: a missing model for wholistic discipleship and pastoral care. In some ministries, the gifting and calling of the individual were celebrated while the whole person—their mental, emotional, and physical health—was quietly overlooked. In others, the knowledge of God and the anchors of doctrinal tradition were honored, but relationship with the Holy Spirit and the cultivation of His gifts were left largely unattended. In both cases something was missing. And the longer I observed, the more I sensed God's grief over sheep who were being tended partially, never quite experiencing the fullness of the abundant life Jesus declared. (John 10:10)

Therefore this ministry is built on the conviction of whole-person discipleship. My pastoral philosophy is to major in the maturity of the soul—the mind, will, and emotions—and to minor in gift and ability. Jesus was fully God and fully man (Phil 2:5–11) — and that truth reveals that we have a model in Christ for what it looks like to be **fully human** in ways many of us have never been taught to care for. He did not simply come to save our souls. He came to show us how to live in them. (3 John 1:2)

God has given me an assignment to establish a place where people can be loved, cared for, equipped, and thrust into the very places He has called them. I liken it to a pit stop. A pit stop is not a place of defeat, it is a place of intentional pause. It is where you rest, reset, are restored, and released back into the race with everything you need to finish. Here you will encounter educators, mental health professionals, artists, ministers, athletes, politicians, and public servants — each carrying a distinct assignment. This is a multi-ethnic community where people of different cultural expressions come together not to erase their differences, but to offer them as gifts to one another and to God. (John 17:20–21)

This is the place of the DISCIPLE — every letter a value and every value a commitment to the whole person. You will find it fully unpacked in the pages that follow.

No matter where you are, this community is here for you. I do not want you to merely know who you are. I want you to understand why God has wired and crafted you the way He did, and what He intends to do with all of it. This is a Union that does not ask you to discard who you are — it is a Union that discovers, honors, and strengthens the uniqueness of who you are in Him.

I invite you, with everything in me, to step into this Union. Together, we become something the world cannot ignore.

Note: Catholicity is not referring to the Roman Catholic Church but rather the one universal Body of Christ.

LEADERSHIP

HOW WE ARE LED

Leadership at The Union Louisville is not a title, it is a function of grace. Rooted in the servant model of Jesus Christ and ordered by the church of Acts and the Ephesians 4 gifts, every leader in this house exists to equip the saints for the work of ministry, not to be served, but to serve. Our structure reflects our conviction that the church is not an institution to be managed, but a living organism to be shepherded — relationally, spiritually, and with deep accountability to God and one another. Authority flows from character and calling, not from position or pedigree. Every role in this ministry exists to make the mission possible and to make the people whole.

Spiritual oversight and shepherding care, upholding doctrine and modeling godly character.

Serve the practical and compassionate needs of the church, promoting unity among the people.

MINISTERS

Emerging voices licensed to preach and serve while continuing their formation journey.

TRUSTEES

Fiduciary and legal stewardship of the church's property, finances, and assets.

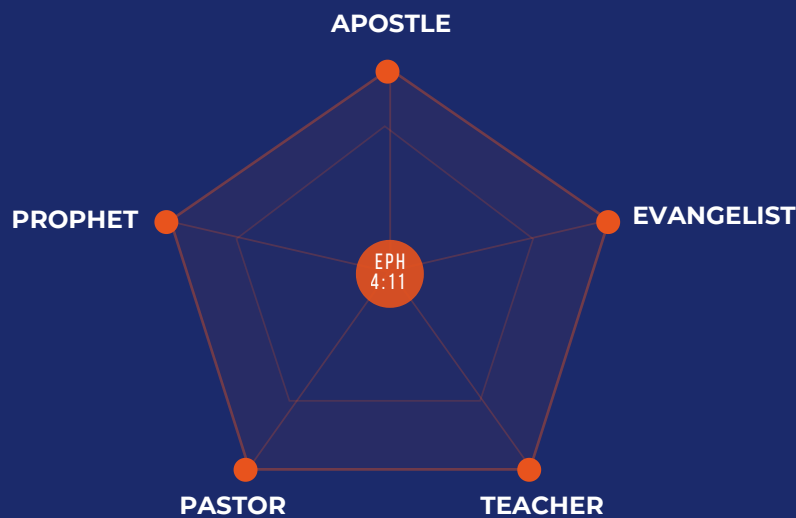

THE FIVE-FOLD MINISTRY COLLECTIVE

This ministry will establish a Five-Fold Ministry Collective — a governing and developmental body composed of recognized voices across all five ministry expressions outlined in Ephesians 4. This Council carries the weight of both governance and formation, ensuring that every layer of the ministry reflects the full expression of Christ to the church and to the world.



1 APOSTLE
Disciples the called — laying foundations, establishing churches, and governing with spiritual authority to advance the Gospel into new territory.

2 PROPHET
Grounds the body — offering Spirit-led discernment, faithful listening, and accountable prophetic community rooted in the Word.

3 EVANGELIST
Deploys the church — igniting passion for the lost and extending the love and message of Christ beyond the walls of the building.

4 PASTOR
Nurtures the congregation — shepherding souls with compassion, care, and the deep commitment to see every person walk in wholeness.

5 TEACHER
Sharpens the mind — providing sound, accessible, and transformative biblical instruction that roots every believer in the truth of God's Word.

THE FIVE-FOLD MINISTRY COLLECTIVE

DISCIPLES THE CALLED

The Collective takes direct responsibility for identifying, mentoring, and developing those who carry specific five-fold graces — ensuring apostles are fathered, prophets grounded, evangelists deployed, pastors nurtured, and teachers sharpened.

ADVISES THE MINISTRY

The Collective serves in an advisory capacity along with the council, bringing five-fold wisdom and spiritual discernment to bear on matters of vision, doctrine, culture, and direction for the broader church community.

MENTORS THE LAITY

The Collective is not insulated from the congregation. Every member of the body has access to five-fold mentorship — because the ministry gifts were given for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry.

Character formation is a curriculum. Students will be developed in integrity, service, personal responsibility, and the ethical framework of Scripture — forming leaders of conscience and credential.

A people made whole in body, mind, and spirit — reflecting the fullness of God's design for human flourishing.

— OUR MISSION

To create a safe and sacred space where individuals encounter the wholistic care of God by embracing mental wellness, honoring the body, and integrating faith into every dimension of health — so that no part of who we are is left outside of His healing reach.

THE HEART BEHIND IT

For too long, the church has celebrated spiritual growth while quietly neglecting the mind and body God gave us. We have prayed over pain we were also meant to address. We have stigmatized mental health struggles that deserve compassion. We have made poor choices with our physical bodies and called it living by faith. This wing exists to say: all of you matters to God.

OUR FOUR CULTURE DECLARATIONS

- **No Judgment.** Every person is met with grace, regardless of where they are, what they have done, or how long they have struggled.
- **No Stigma.** Mental health struggles are human struggles, not spiritual failures. We will never make someone feel ashamed for needing help.
- **No Compartmentalization.** God cares about all of you and so do we. Your body, your mind, and your spirit are equally welcome here.
- **Full Dignity.** Every body. Every mind. Every background. Every story. You are seen, valued, and worthy of wholistic care.

— WHOLISTIC HEALTH & WELLNESS

Three Pillars of Wholistic Care

Our approach to wholistic health is a posture. Built on three interdependent pillars, this wing addresses the full person: mind, body, and spirit. Each pillar is designed not to stand alone but to reinforce the others, because we believe true healing is never partial.



I

Renew the Mind

Breaking the stigma of mental health in the church. We believe that caring for the mind is not a lack of faith instead it is an act of faithful stewardship over the life God has given us. This pillar creates space for honest conversations, professional support, and pastoral care that holds mental wellness and spiritual formation together.



II

Honor the Body

Making wiser, more intentional choices with our physical health. The body is the temple of the Holy Spirit and we are called to steward it with the same intentionality we bring to our prayer life. This pillar equips the community with practical tools, education, and accountability for physical wellness rooted in biblical conviction.



III

Integrate the Spirit

Faith is not separate from health, it is the foundation of it. This pillar anchors the entire wing in the presence and power of God, ensuring that every dimension of care — physical, emotional, psychological — is held within the context of relationship with Christ and the community of faith.
